As leaders in the pro-life community, we write to voice our approval of recent Congressional efforts to expand the Child Tax Credit (CTC), and urge Congress to work together in the coming days to ensure a meaningful CTC expansion becomes law.

It shows our lawmakers' enduring commitment to celebrating and defending the lives of children, as well as the parents raising them. We offer our support in this important effort and urge Congress to continue on until an expanded CTC is codified, to the benefit of millions of American families.
